2 positions: Volunteering in different programme lines

We are looking for **two full-time volunteer** who will support the Foundation for the duration of 10 months in 2024: One position starting **on 2nd January** 2024 (please send us your application until 19.11.2023), and another position starting **in November** 2024 (please send us your application until 15.12.2023).



The activities of both positions are planned within different teams throughout your volunteering time: You will have the chance to work with our colleagues in the teams of Understanding Europe, the Young Islam Conference, or Communications. You take on a wide range of everyday tasks. The following list are examples and will be implemented depending on your background, talents and preferences, which will be discussed during the interview:

- Supporting with administration tasks within the foundation Helping to coordinate current projects, events, trainings and webinars
- Assisting with communications tasks (social media, website, printed materials)
- Supporting our data systems, e.g. by working on a platform or updating databases
- Assisting the creation of reports and funding applications and Preparing evaluations and polls

4 positions: Volunteering in the International office of the European Youth Parliament

We are looking for **four full-time volunteers** who will support the work of the European Youth Parliament (EYP) for 12 months: Starting **between July 1st and August 1st (one position latest September 1st) 2024.** We can explore different start dates in summer 2024, please flag in your applications when you are available to start. Please send us your application until **20.11.2023**.

The EYP is a unique educational programme which brings together young people from all over Europe to discuss current topics in a parliamentary setting. The EYP is a network consisting of 40 European associations and organisations, in which thousands of young people are active in a voluntary capacity. The international umbrella organisation of the EYP is the Schwarzkopf Foundation, hosting the International Office of the EYP. You will support Project Managers, as the call is for different positions, the list of tasks is not exclusively attached to one of the positions and preferences will be discussed during the interview:

- Preparations and coordination of our governance events (EYP Board of National Committees and Governing Body)
- Everyday support with financial management (reviewing submitted invoices, preparing reimbursement forms)
- Preparation and help around organising events in Berlin
- Participant management for the International Sessions
- Assisting with communications tasks (social media, EYP website, printed materials)
- Enabling growth and improvement of the EYP's community of dedicated volunteers and supporting knowledge exchange among EYP's national committees
- Supporting the work of the EYP International Office in general, like preparing and updating databases, supporting the creation of reports, funding applications or



administering evaluations and polls
