About EYE Berlin

Dear reader.

We are happy that we have sparked your interest in EYE Berlin and we hope you will decide to register as a participant! In this booklet, you will find more information about the event and what to expect from the event.

Let's get it started!

What's a Local EYE?

A Local EYE is a local version of the European Local Event, which usually takes place in Strasbourg. For 2024, four cities have been selected to host a local EYE:

- Berlin (Germany) 18-20 April
- Vilnius (Lithuania) 3-4 May
- Forlì (Italy) 17-19 May
- Brežice (Slovenia) 23-26 May

Local EYEs bring the unique experience of the EYE (European Youth Event) to Europe's cities and regions, offering young people across the continent the opportunity to meet other young people, inspire one another and exchange ideas with experts, activists and decision-makers. This environment is obtained by mixing a variety of different activities, where participants have the opportunity to interact and learn from each other.

Local EYEs are co-funded and supported by the European Parliament and are organised by youth organisations to bring Europe closer to young people, empowering them to become active citizens and to engage with the European Parliament. **EYE Berlin is organised by the European Youth Parliament (EYP) and its volunteers**.

What's EYP?

The European Youth Parliament (EYP) is one of Europe's largest youth platforms for civic education, intercultural encounters, and the exchange of ideas – run by young people, for young people.

Founded in 1987, it is active in more than 35 countries and aims at inspiring and empowering a young generation of informed, open-minded, responsible, and active citizens who shape society and drive impact.

Every year, the EYP organises international, national and regional events that bring together around 25,000 young Europeans, offering them a safe space to develop and express their opinions, build intercultural understanding and develop active citizenship skills.

EYP events are based on non-formal peer education: participants learn and develop a diverse set of skills through a fully immersive social, cultural and educational programme, completely shaped and led by trained young Europeans.

EYE Berlin, in short

As the name suggests, EYE Berlin will take place in Berlin, Germany, between the 18th and the 20th of April 2024.

It will gather around 2.000 young Europeans, both physically and digitally, who are eager to meet with their peers and experts, to discuss and exchange opinions and ideas.

EYE Berlin is based on five thematic pillars:

- I. The European Elections: champion the cause of youth representation, advocacy, and active participation in the 2024 European Elections, ensuring that the priorities and aspirations of young Europeans are at the forefront of the electoral agenda. EYE Berlin wants to promote civic engagement and empower young people to be active, informed citizens who play an integral role in shaping the future of Europe through their involvement in democratic processes.
- II. **United Europe:** promote peace and intercultural understanding among European youth, emphasising the role of young people in building a harmonious and inclusive Europe. EYE Berlin aims at creating spaces for intercultural dialogue, fostering understanding among young people from diverse backgrounds, and empowering them to actively engage in civic life, thereby contributing to a more united and cohesive European society.
- III. **Sustainable Europe:** advance Europe's transition to sustainability by inspiring young Europeans to take an active role in shaping a greener and more environmentally conscious Europe, aligning with the goals of the European Year of Skills.
- IV. Innovative Europe: empower youth in their professional development by providing them with the knowledge of how and where to acquire the skills and resources needed to thrive in a rapidly changing job market, in line with the objectives of the European Year of Skills. EYE Berlin focuses on fostering personal growth and self-fulfilment, encouraging young people to engage in volunteerism, extracurricular activities, internships, and other opportunities that enrich their skills, broaden their horizons, and prepare them for successful and fulfilling careers.
- V. Capacity-building for youth NGOs designed specifically for youth organisations: strengthen the capacities, connections, and capabilities of European youth organisations, equipping them to better serve their communities, grow sustainably, and advocate for the issues that matter most to young people.

Workshops and events at EYE Berlin will be dedicated to one or more than one of those pillars; they shape the direction of discussions and interventions.

A more specific list of the available workshops and activities will be presented and shared with participants closer to the event.

What to expect

EYE Berlin is a dynamic platform for young Europeans to collaborate, share ideas, and tackle key societal challenges together. This event is your chance to immerse in diverse cultures, meet new people, and engage in meaningful exchanges.

EYE Berlin will take place at two levels: physical and online.

Physical Participation:

Participating physically is a dynamic and immersive experience. Young individuals from across Europe converge at a vibrant location, creating a palpable atmosphere of energy and diversity. Attendees have the opportunity to engage in face-to-face interactions, network with peers from different countries, and actively contribute to workshops, panel discussions, and collaborative projects.

Please note: physical participation in EYE Berlin is free of charge. However, participants are expected to cover their own expenses, including accommodation, food and transportation to Berlin. As of now, the Organising Team is unable to offer financial support.

Online Participation:

For those unable to attend physically, the EYE extends its reach through online participation, ensuring inclusivity and accessibility. Virtual attendees can access a selection of live-streamed sessions, participate in remote workshops, and engage in discussions through online forums.

5. Receive personalised schedule

Shortly after expressing your preferences, you will receive a personalised schedule, mapping out your plan for EYE Berlin and maximising your opportunities for learning and networking.

6. Meet in Berlin!

The culmination of these steps will bring you to Berlin, having the opportunity to mix with other participants from diverse backgrounds and engage in exciting activities!

Online Participation

If you opt to join EYE Berlin online, you may have to wait a little more time. But make sure to still check out the official pages to not miss the dedicated call. Anyhow, what does online participation involve?

1. Follow platforms to access the link for online participation

We want to engage the largest number of participants possible, so it may take some time for the Organising Team to get ready for online participation but we want you there! So please be patient and keep checking the EYE Berlin pages.

2. Register for the workshops

Once online workshops are defined, you will be able to register through the dedicated link for the activities you would like to join. Workshops will be designed to maximise your experience, even if distant.

3. Receive links and have fun!

Shortly before the events start, you will receive the link to the workshop(s) you have selected. Join the call and have fun!
